### Kariong Mountains High School Update on Organisational Changes as of 16/03/20

- The Year 7 camp has been postponed until Week 2, Term 4. Parents, who have already paid will have the camp costs held 'in trust', so that minimal paperwork and organisation will be required for their child to attend on this new date. Some student spots will open up for parents, who missed out and paperwork will come out in Term 3 for those wanting to take up this opportunity. Parents requiring a refund will need to notify the school by Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March, by email or written note, and we will process as per DoE policy. *Please note that it can take up to three weeks for a refund to be processed.*
- All VET work placements and work experience have been cancelled for the rest of the term, as directed by TAFE. Students should attend school for normal timetabled lessons
- All sporting events, even those that were due to be held locally, have been cancelled for the rest of the term. All CHS and 'outside the local area' events have been cancelled.
- Most out of school interest groups have been cancelled and only those that meet the self-distancing recommendations and have no transport will go ahead.
- If a student has to self-isolate due to a health condition as advised by a doctor, then we will endeavour to provide work, as soon as possible, with a priority to Stage 6 students.
