SAY NO TO VAPING

E-cigarettes are not only **addictive**, but also contain or produce harmful chemicals and toxins that can cause serious health problems. The nicotine found in them is highly addictive and can affect brain development in teens, *impacting their learning*, concentration and mood, causing anxiety and depression.

The use of e-cigarettes among young people is a growing concern on the Central Coast and indeed across all of Australia. NSW Health's *Say No to Vaping* campaign aims to raise awareness, debunk myths and empower teens to make informed decisions.

Mythbusters:

Myth: Vaping is not bad for your health

FACT: Many e-cigarettes contain or produce chemicals and toxins such as formaldehyde and heavy metals that can cause DNA damage, serious lung damage and cancer. They also contain other chemicals not found in tobacco smoke, and it is not yet known what effects these will have on your health in the long-term — so why take the risk?

Myth: You can't get addicted to Vaping

FACT: Most e-cigarettes contain nicotine the same <u>highly-addictive chemical</u> that's in regular cigarettes.

Myth: E-cigarettes contain less nicotine

FACT: Depending on the size and type of e-cigarette, they can contain as much nicotine as up to three entire packs of cigarettes!

Myth: Vaping will help you stop smoking

FACT: There is not enough evidence to prove e-cigarettes are effective at helping smokers quit. That is why they are not an approved product for helping people to quit. Worse, studies have shown high school students who start using e-cigarettes are much more likely to begin smoking regular cigarettes as well.

Myth: Vaping is safer for the environment

FACT: Vapes waste is <u>especially bad</u> for the environment due to single-use plastic, hazardous and toxic chemicals and electronic waste produced from lithium-ion batteries and heating elements.

Myth: All vaping is legal

FACT: In NSW, it is illegal to sell e-cigarettes or e-cigarette accessories to a person under 18 years of age. It is illegal to sell e-cigarettes containing nicotine to all ages. It is also illegal to use e-cigarettes in places where smoking is illegal.




MATHEMATICS






