


#### YEAR 12 CONGRATULATIONS

#### **LESSONS**

Rock and Water is a highly successful, evidenced based ternational educational program. Australia over 80,000 teachers, youth workers, chaptains and punsellors have received training nee the program was introduced by Freerk Ykema in 1998. Our BBMA teachers are a part of this Rock and Water trained offessional cohort with Kyoshi Liz Mahler a 'Master Trainer'.

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

When? Monday the 16th, Tuesday the 17th and Wednesday the 18th of January. Black Belt Martial Arts runs School Holiday Camps. First half of the day will be Rock and Water course, and the second half will be School Holiday activities.

Drop off is from 8:30 and pickup is from either 12:30pm (half day) or 3:00pm (full day).
