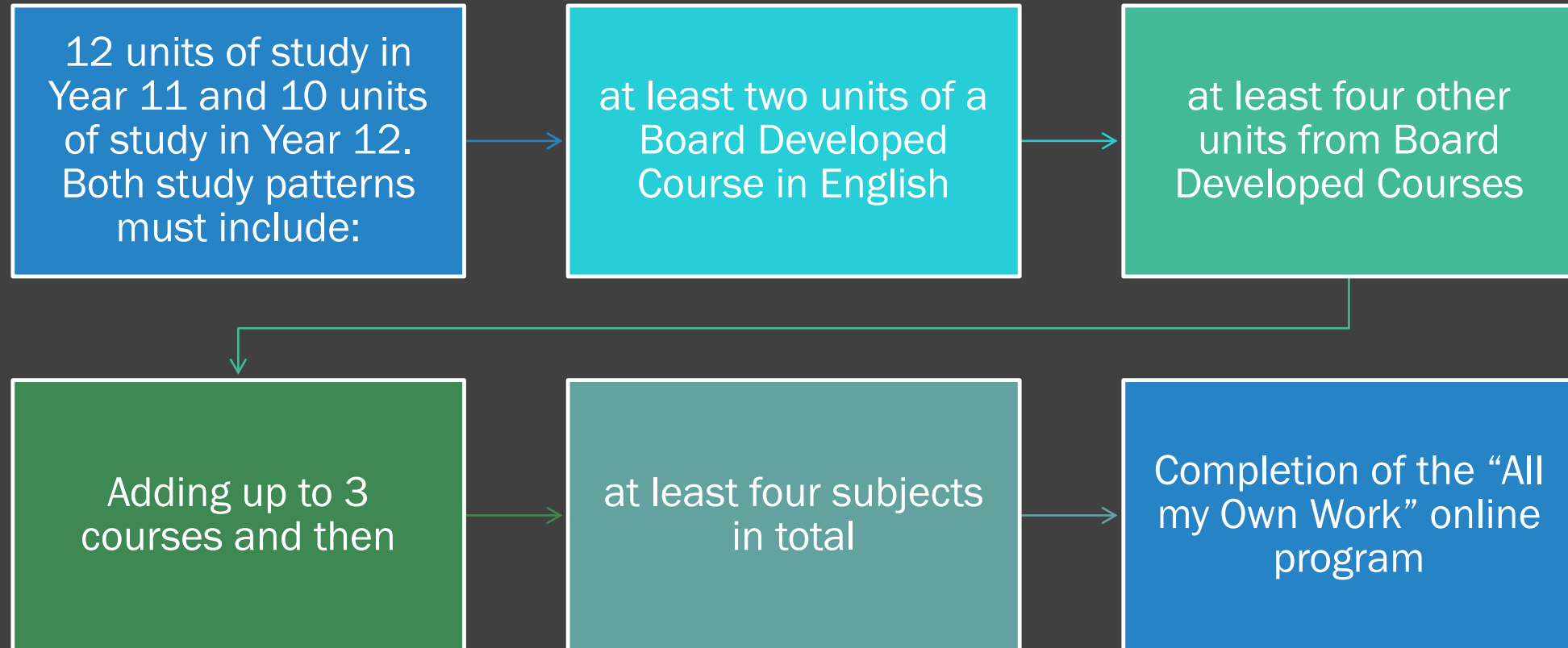



It is **one of the pathways** for getting into university courses at specific universities

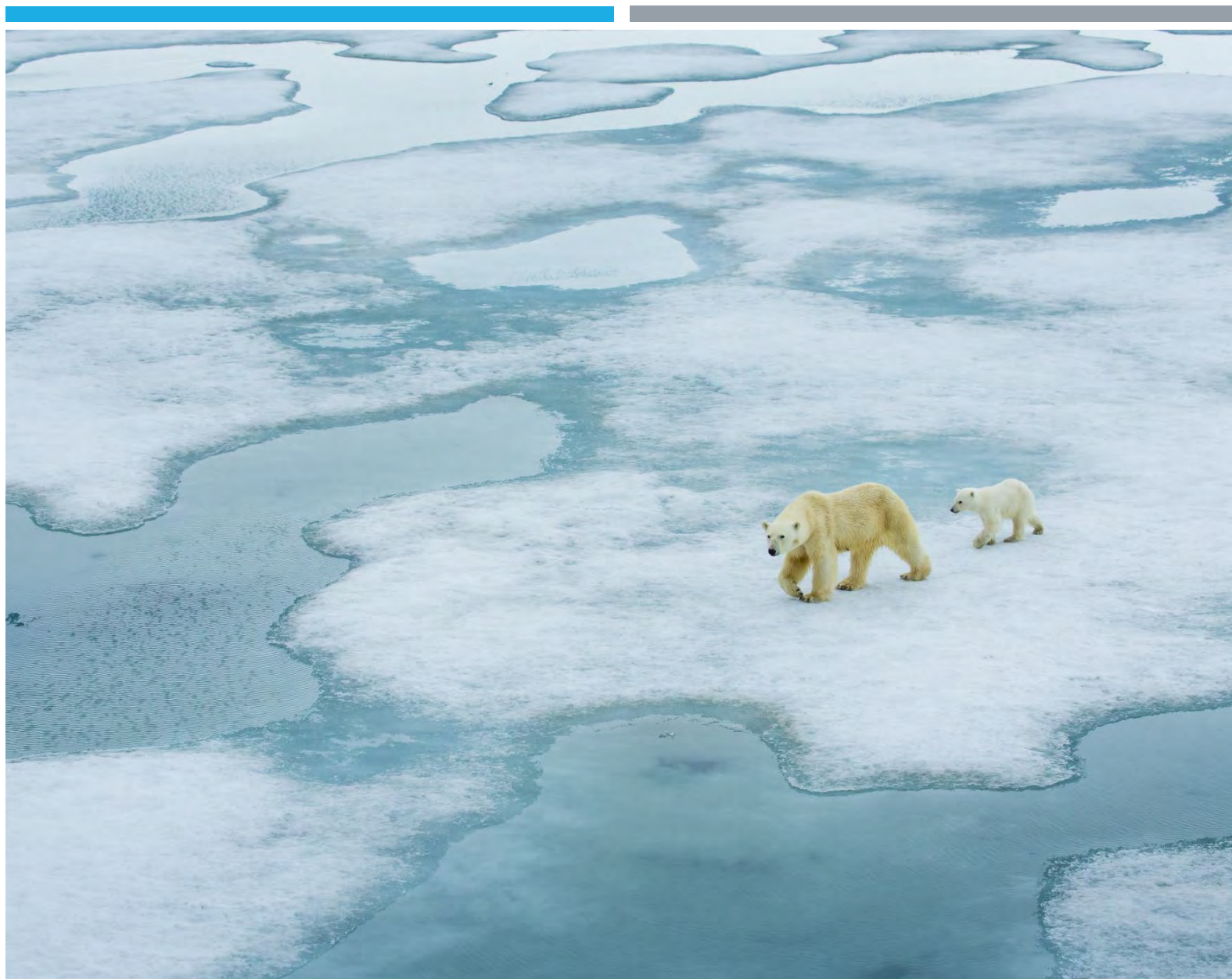
It is generally used by students, who have firm plans and goals of going straight from school to university
