## Uniform Policy and Local Practices

### *Implementation Procedures*

### *The following outlines our school's local practices:*

Students out of uniform are to report to the Deputy's office before 8:50am and a uniform pass will be issued. Alternatively, students can present a note to their check-in teacher. Students without a note from home will have an incident recorded on Compass.

Staff are encouraged to ask students for a pass throughout the day (*including playground and classes*). Students, who fail to present a pass, are to have it recorded as an incident on Compass and referred to the Deputy. Compass entries will be monitored by the Deputy Principal.

Students, who are repeatedly out of uniform, will serve a detention.

Students, who attend school wearing inappropriate clothing, including 'very short' shorts, leggings and/or clothing with any offensive logo, graphic or print, will be referred to the uniform pool. If there are no items available, the student will be removed from the playground.

**WH&S requires that students are to wear fully covered leather shoes in all practical subjects.**
